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solving abilities, and punctuality among our students. These are key attributes that contribute significantly to a well-rounded professional, and addressing them will further strengthen the preparedness of our graduates for the workforce.

3. On a positive note, it is encouraging that all employers expressed a willingness to recruit graduates from our college. This favorable outcome underscores the overall strength of our academic programs and the high regard in which our graduates are held by employers, providing a solid foundation for future collaboration and success.
