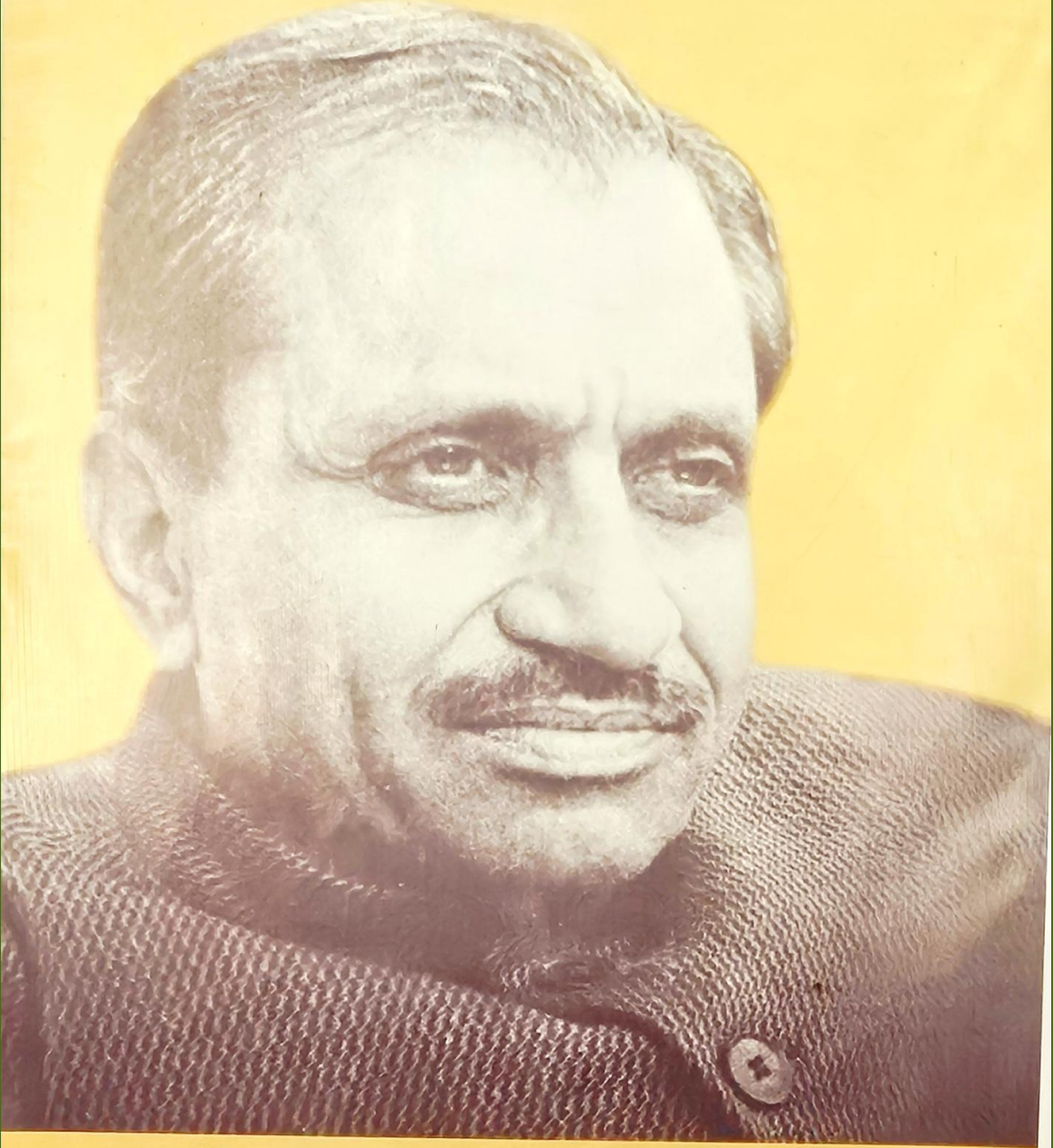

COLLEGE PROFILE

About the college

Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya (PDUAM), Tulungia is a Model College established under the co-venture of the Central Government and the Government of Assam. The college is an outcome of the centrally sponsored scheme named "Rashtriya Uchchattar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA)" launched in 2013 by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India which aims at providing strategic funding in higher educational institutions throughout the country. Funding is provided by the Central Ministry through the State Governments and Union Territories, which in coordination with the Central Project Appraisal Board, monitor the academic, administrative and financial advancements taken under the scheme.

The college was inaugurated on 30th August 2017 by Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, the then Honourable Health, Finance & Education Minister, Govt. of Assam. The academic session commenced on 31st August 2017 and since then it has been functioning as a Model College to inculcate higher education among the rural masses of Bongaigaon district of Assam. Presently, the college has a teaching strength of Fifty-Two teachers serving in the three streams i.e. Commerce, Science and Arts under different departments, viz., Accountancy, Commerce (Finance), Management, English, Environmental Science, Mathematics, Statistics, Assamese, Information Technology, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Education, History, Economics, Political Science and Sociology. Besides, the college has a Central library and a Computer laboratory. In addition to the teaching staff, there are ten non-teaching staff in different cadre. PDUAM, Tulungia is a residential college offering hostel accommodation for girl students only.



The college is affiliated under Gauhati University. PDUAM, Tulungia was accorded *UGC recognition (2f status)* in the year 2020 and it had also achieved the distinction of *B++ Accreditation (CGPA 2.77)* by NAAC in its very first cycle of NAAC Assessment in 2024.



The college is situated in close proximity to the National Highway no. 37. It is located within the vicinity of the village, Tulungia, covering an estimated area of 25 bighas of land and has a provision for further expansion. The areas surrounding the college are endowed with substantial natural resource based on bamboo and fish ponds. Additionally, the area is acclaimed for its breathtaking scenic beauty which offers a potent scope for tourism.

Majority of the villagers residing around the college are educationally and financially backward. Although, there is adequate number of schools in and around the locality, the opportunities to pursue higher education are few. The college claims to develop the intellect of our students as it offers Commerce, Science and Arts education under the guidance of a dedicated, energetic and experienced faculty, working along with an efficient administrative staff. The transport and communication facilities in the area are convenient. The college is well connected with its district headquarter i.e. Bongaigaon as well as to the state capital.

Vision

We stand to impart accessible, affordable and excellent value-based quality education to enable our students to achieve their full potential and to gain employability in a competitive business world.

- a) Provide adequate opportunities of higher education to the socially backward classes and promote education among the minorities, differently-abled and girl students.

Institutional participation in NIRF and AISHE survey

The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) is an initiative launched in the year 2015 by the Ministry of Education, Government of India to create a transparent, data-driven system for comparing Indian Universities and colleges.

Every year, thousands of institutions submit their data and NIRF evaluates them using specific parameters. The parameters broadly cover- “Teaching, Learning and Resources,” “Research and Professional Practices,” “Graduation Outcomes,” “Outreach and Inclusivity,” and “Perception”. *PDUAM, Tulungia has been consistently participating in the NIRF assessment cycle since the year 2024.*

Likewise, the All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) under the Ministry of Education, Government of India is an annual web-based survey of the higher educational institutions of the country. The primary objective of AISHE is to portray the status of higher education in the country by collecting comprehensive data on various parameters such as student enrolment, programmes offered, examination results, infrastructure, faculty details, and financial information.

The data uploaded by the college contributes to policy formulation, planning, and development of the higher education sector at the national level. Through active participation in AISHE, the college ensures transparency and accountability while strengthening the national database on higher education. *Since its establishment, PDUAM, Tulungia has been regularly participating in the AISHE survey and the AISHE Code of the college is C-59837.*

COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Code of Conduct

- ❖ The Identity Card should be brought to the college every day and is to be produced whenever asked for.
- ❖ Using mobile phone inside the classroom is strictly prohibited. Violation of the rule must be liable to pay a fine or expulsion from the college or both.
- ❖ Each academic session will run as per the Academic Calendar published by Gauhati University.
- ❖ Attendance in all classes is compulsory.
- ❖ Chewing paan masala, gutka or any other tobacco products, smoking or consumption of any other intoxicating products is strictly prohibited in and around the college campus.
- ❖ Smoking, spitting, throwing waste indecently, destroying college property, making noise and loitering in the college campus may lead to pecuniary fine or expulsion from the college or both.
- ❖ All forms of ragging in the college or in the Hostel are strictly prohibited. Strong disciplinary action will be taken against those involved in such activities.
- ❖ The decisions of competent/appropriate bodies on all matters relating to students' indiscipline shall be final and binding.

Attendance Requirements

To be eligible to sit for the examinations as a “Regular” candidate, the student should have at least 75% of attendance in classes. Students having attendance below 75% may be declared “Non-collegiate” or “Dis-collegiate” potentially barring them from appearing in the end-semester examinations.

Examination and Evaluation system

- ❖ The following examinations are conducted by the College during an academic year:
 - Class Tests
 - HS 1st/2nd Year Unit test and Half-yearly Examination
 - FYUGP B. A./B. Com/B. Sc. Sessional Examination in every semester
- ❖ All students must appear in the examinations conducted by the college. In case of illness, sick bed will be provided.
- ❖ Any unfair means during examination or violation of examination rules will invite disciplinary action against the student concerned.
- ❖ As per the Gauhati University Regulations for Examination 2023, the evaluation of each course paper will have the following components:
 - Internal assessment
 - Practical assessment (*in case of paper with practical*)
 - End-semester/Theory Examination
- ❖ A student must secure a minimum of 40% marks in every component (Internal, Practical and Theory) separately to pass a paper.
- ❖ Students who fail a paper can re-appear for it in alternate semesters.
- ❖ A student pursuing FYUGP has to complete the entire programme within a period of seven years including the multiple entry and exit, if any.
- ❖ Result sheets of defaulters on account of College Hostel/NCC/Sports/Student’s Union/Library matters will be kept withheld.
- ❖ Re-admission of unsuccessful students will be governed by “College Admission Rules”.

College Uniform

The College uniform is compulsory for every working day. Students without uniform will not be allowed to enter the college campus.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES AND COURSE STRUCTURE

Regular courses

PDUAM, Tulungia offers regular courses to learners at both *Higher Secondary (HS)* and *Under Graduate (UG)* levels across the three streams, namely, *Commerce, Science and Arts*.

HIGHER SECONDARY (HS) COURSE DETAILS

Duration: 2 years

Intake capacity: Commerce (150), Science (120), Arts (150)

In compliance with the updated course structure prescribed by the Assam State School Education Board (ASSEB) Division-II [erstwhile Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC)], the college has offered the following list of subjects for HS 1st year (Academic session 2026-27) under different categories for the three streams:

FOUR-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP) COURSE DETAILS

Under NEP 2020, as per the Gauhati University Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (GU-FYUGP), PDUAM, Tulungia offers Bachelor's Degree in three streams, namely, B. Com (in Major discipline), B.Sc (in Major and Minor disciplines) and B.A (in Major and Minor disciplines).

The complete FYUGP consists of 8 semesters, to be completed in a minimum of 4 academic years. Each academic year has two semesters. The FYUGP curriculum is divided into two parts — (i) Core Courses and (ii) Common Courses. The Core Courses constitute Majors and Minors. Whereas, the Common Courses include Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), Multi-disciplinary Courses (MDC), Value-added Courses (VAC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and Internship which are to be studied by all students of FYUGP.

The successful completion of a GU-FYUGP programme (B. Com/B.Sc./B. A.) depends on the student's earning of a *minimum number of Credits* specified for the programme. *Credit* is a unit of measurement of the course work. Each semester has a minimum credit allocation of 22, totaling the minimum credit allocation for a 3-year programme to 120 credits. With the fourth year, the minimum credit requirements become 160. A student can, however, earn up to a maximum of 132 credits in a 3-year programme and 176 by the fourth year.

The FYUGP Programme offers multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options to the students, with appropriate certifications such as:

- ❖ a UG Certificate after completing 1 year (2 semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study *plus* an extra Vocational/Skill Course of 4 credits,
- ❖ a UG Diploma after 2 years (4 semesters) of study *plus* an extra Vocational/Skill Course of 4 credits,
- ❖ a Bachelor's degree after a 3-year (6 semesters) programme of study,
- ❖ a 4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours) after 8 semesters programme of study and a 4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours with research) in case the student completes a rigorous research project in their major area(s) of study in the 4th year.

It should be noted that any certificate / diploma / degree is awarded only if the student clears (i.e. passes) all the required courses (papers) till that point of time.

As per the Gauhati University SOP and Guidelines for Introduction of 4th year of the FYUGP in Colleges affiliated to Gauhati University, PDUAM, Tulungia will be introducing the 4th year of B. Com/B.Sc./B. A. FYUGP for its students from the academic session 2026-27.

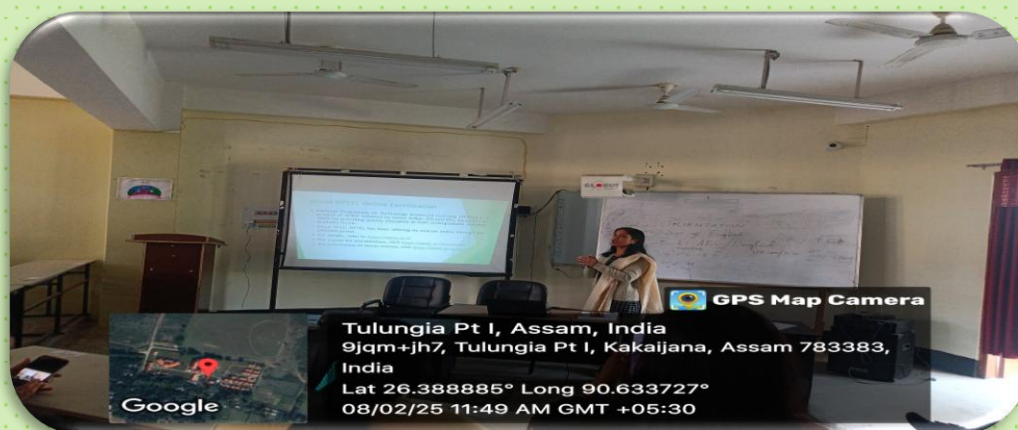
SWAYAM STUDY CENTRE cum SWAYAM-NPTEL LOCAL CHAPTER

II. Any other Equivalent Examination recognized by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (Presently Assam State School Education Board, Division-II)

- **FYUGP Course:** To apply for admission in to FYUGP B. Com/B. Sc/B. A. 1st Semester, a student has to pass-

I. HSSLC Examination (10+2) in concerned stream under the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (Presently Assam State School Education Board, Division-II)

Or

II. Any other Equivalent Examination recognized by Gauhati University

N.B.: Admission to B. Com/B. A. 1st semester shall be open to candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) examination in Commerce/Science/Arts stream subject to availability of seats. However, for B.Sc. 1st Semester, only those candidates who have passed the HS examination in Science stream are eligible to apply.

Admission procedure

Required documents

2. Marksheet(s) of the last qualifying examination(s)
3. Registration certificate
4. Original or Provisional Pass certificate/Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended
5. Migration Certificate, if applicable
6. Gap certificate from competent authority, if applicable
7. Caste certificate, if applicable
8. PwD certificate, if applicable
9. Parents's/Guardian's Income certificate and/or other specified documents (in case of fee waiver)
10. For admission under fee waiver, photograph of a planted sapling by the student has to be submitted at the time of admission
11. Bank pass book
12. Any other document, as notified by the Admission Committee concerned.

Note:

1. Admission to all courses of study in the college is strictly on the basis of merit. The decision of the *Admission Committee* will be binding and final.
2. Admission to a Programme or Major will be subject to availability of the subject and capacity of the college / department.
3. Reservation of seats under Caste quota will be as per the standing rules of the Government of Assam [OBC/MOBC– 27%, SC-7%, ST(P) – 10%, ST(H) – 5%, PwD – 3%]. In this respect, caste certificate issued by the competent authority under Govt. of Assam only shall be valid.
4. The candidates seeking admission to HS 1st Year/FYUGP First semester must pass the last qualifying examination in the year 2025. In case, a candidate had passed the last qualifying examination before 2025 and applies for admission, he/she must produce a *Gap Certificate* in original on the day of admission. The competent authority from whom Gap Certificate should be obtained is as follows:
 - Medical officers not below the rank of Medical Superintendent with his/her contact number.

- The Head Master/Principal where the candidates studied last certifying that the candidate is well known to him/her along with the contact number.
 - The Block Development Officer (BDO) certifying that the candidate is well known to him/her along with the contact number.
5. The list of selected candidates will be notified in the college website and admitted as per Admission Schedule.
 6. If a candidate fails to report on the day of admission as per list and schedule, his/her candidature will be forfeited.
 7. A General Waiting list of candidates who may be called for admission will be notified in due course of time. Admission of the candidates from the Waiting List may be considered on the last day of the scheduled dates depending upon the number of vacant seats.
 8. Admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of ASSEB (Div II)/Gauhati University, as applicable.
 9. Doubtful documents will be subjected to verification to the issuing authority/seizure of documents/may be followed by action of law.
 10. A student seeking admission in the *college hostel* must collect a separate application form from the office of the college and has to be submit the same within the stipulated time.
 11. Admission in to HS 2nd year will take place after the declaration of HS 1st year Final Examination results, subject to the notification issued by ASSEB (Div II) in this regard.
 12. Admission in to FYUGP 3rd, 5th and 7th Semesters will take place after the completion of 2nd, 4th and 6th End Semester Examinations respectively, subject to the notification issued by Gauhati University in this regard.

College Library

A library is the heart of an educational institution. Library of Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya, Tulungia is located at the first floor of the college building with a very rich collection in various subjects covering all textbooks, reference books, journals and newspapers. Students may borrow books from the library against their Library Cards. They may read various newspapers and journals in the reading room of the library.



The central library is a fully automated one. Integrated library management software SOUL 2.0 has been installed in the library in 2020. The PDUAM library has digitalised reader attendance system. There is a digital library section through which the users can access different e-

resources along with previous question papers, college journal, magazine, newsletter etc. The college library is also registered on the One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) platform which caters to the research and development needs of its users.

Library rules and regulations

1. Library membership can be achieved by filling up library membership form. Students must submit the following documents along with library membership form:
 - a) Photocopy of admission receipt.
 - b) Photocopy of address proof (Aadhar Card/Birth Certificate/Electricity Bill/Voter ID Card/Passport).
 - c) Two passport size photos.
2. A student must bring his/her library card to the library and can borrow maximum two books for a period of 15 days. He/she must return the books within 15 days from the date of issue, failure of which a late fine of Rs. 2.00 per day will be charged.
3. A book can be renewed for another 15 days (for one time only).
4. Students must deposit their belongings (Bag, mobile etc.) in the property counter before entering inside the library.
5. Students must put their Name, class/semester, roll no, purpose of visit, time of entry, time of departure and signature in the gate register at the time of entering into the library.
6. Silence shall be strictly observed in the library.
7. Conversation, making noise, spitting, and smoking inside the library are strictly prohibited.
8. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in and around the library.
9. Students should carefully examine the books issued to them before leaving the Library Counter. They shall bring immediately to the notice of the librarian about any damage or mutilation of the book issued. Otherwise, the borrower will be held responsible for any damage of mutilation and is required to replace it.

Wi-Fi

Our college is committed to digital empowerment and provides free high-speed Wi-Fi across the entire campus, including classrooms, library, computer laboratory, departments, examination board and common areas. With seamless internet access, students can attend online lectures, access e-journals and stay connected with global learning resources anytime.

Laboratory facility

Our college takes pride in its modern, well-equipped science laboratories that transform theoretical learning into hands-on discovery. The Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology labs are furnished with advanced

instruments. Here, students don't just perform prescribed experiments; they are encouraged to innovate, design projects, and participate in research under faculty mentorship. These labs serve as the foundation for

developing scientific temper, analytical skills, and practical expertise, preparing our students for higher studies, research, and industry roles.



In the age of digitalization and globalization, the role of computer is not only essential for students' community but for each and every individual too. With a view to develop the knowledge on computer application in day to- day life, one computer lab with eighteen computers has been functioning with all modern amenities in the college.

Digital/Smart classroom

There is a smart classroom in the college equipped with a digital board installed with all necessary features. This room is being used as a classroom cum seminar room for the learners of the college.



Common Service Centre (CSC) for students

The PDUAMT College Student Welfare and Common Service Centre serves as the backbone of student support. The Common Service Centre within the college acts as a one-stop digital hub for form submission, admit card downloads, applications for government-funded schemes, printing, scanning, photocopying, and

preparation of project-related work. Students can also apply for various jobs through this centre. The CSC provides all these services at a very minimal rate to the student community.

Hostel

The college provides safe, comfortable, and well-managed residential facilities for girl students to ensure a secure and supportive environment away from home.

Hostel accommodates 68 boarders. The hostel offers spacious, well-ventilated rooms with 2-3 occupancy, furnished with beds, study tables and wardrobes. Facilities include 24x7 security with CCTV surveillance, a dedicated female warden, common room cum reading hall, dining hall, hygienic mess providing nutritious meals, RO drinking water, power backup, geyser facility, and medical care with first-aid.

New Girls' Hostel

A new girls' hostel has been constructed inside the college campus, designed to accommodate around 34 boarders. This new hostel is expected to be functional from the academic session 2026-27, in addition to the existing one.

Canteen

PDUAM, Tulungia, has a spacious canteen which is open to students, teachers, guests, and any other visitors. It serves delicious and hygienic food at reasonable prices. Common food items are easily available in the canteen.



Fitness Centre cum Gymnasium

With a view to inculcate physical education among students and faculty members of the college, a fitness centre cum Gymnasium has been set up with all modern equipments.



Quarter Facility

The college features a secure, self-contained residential campus with dedicated quarters for both teaching and non-teaching staff. Located within the college premises, the staff quarters ensure a peaceful living environment and promote a strong academic community. Faculty and staff residing inside the campus benefit from greater interaction with students, quick access to laboratories and library, and the ability to mentor students beyond class hours. The residential campus also includes internal roads, street lighting, CCTV surveillance, and green open spaces, fostering a safe and family-friendly atmosphere.

Auditorium

The college boasts of a modern auditorium with a seating capacity of 300, equipped with advanced acoustics, digital sound system, and a spacious stage with green rooms. It serves as the hub for seminars, conferences, cultural programs, annual functions, guest lectures, and inter-college events, providing students a professional platform to showcase their talents and interact with experts.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Grievance redressal cell

The college has a Grievance Redressal Cell to address the concerns of students, teaching and non-teaching staff, and other stakeholders. The primary task of the Cell is to receive, examine, and resolve grievances in a fair and time-bound manner. It ensures confidentiality and impartiality while dealing with complaints related to academic matters, examination, harassment, discrimination, infrastructure, or administrative issues.

Student feedback system

The Research and Development Cell of our college collects feedback every year from the under-graduate students, parents and employers to ensure continuous improvement in academic quality and overall development. This feedback helps us understand expectations from all stakeholders and make necessary enhancements.

Scholarships

To facilitate different national and state level scholarships, our college has deputed an Institute Nodal Officer (INO) under the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It is an online portal by the Government of India for applying, processing, verifying and sanction of Government scholarships to students. The portal distributes funds through the Direct Benefit Transfer system.

It includes various Central sector, centrally sponsored and State sponsored scholarships like *Ishan Uday Special Scholarship scheme for NER, Post Matric scholarship to ST, SC and OBC students*. The Cell also carries out the verification

process for *Nijut Moina Asoni* to female students and *Nijut Babu Asoni* to the male students of the institute.

In the 2024-2025 session, 43 students availed Post Matric scholarship to ST, 202 students availed the Post Matric scholarship to OBC students and 06 students availed the Ishan Uday scholarship.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. NSS Unit, PDUAM Tulungia was formed in 2017 to provide exposure to the students for regular and special camping activities in college and community. NSS is a great platform for students to shape his/her character in this budding stage by engaging in various community related activities. Any student can voluntarily join as an NSS volunteer. Being an active member, the student volunteers would have the exposure and experience to be an accomplished social leader, an efficient administrator, a person who understands human nature.

Since the formation of the NSS unit, PDUAM Tulungia, the unit has been engaging in different college and community related activities like *seven days special camping in adopted village, tree plantation, awareness rallies and*

programmes on various social issues etc. The volunteers of the NSS Unit also participated in state, regional and national level programmes like Personality and life skill development programme in Guwahati, North East NSS Festival held in Tripura, National Integration camp (NIC) held in Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.



Student Mentoring

Mentoring of students is very important for their overall development. In our college, mentors are appointed for each student to provide academic guidance, personal support, and career counselling. The mentoring process is operated through the Academic Council of the college, which ensures that students receive regular interaction, monitoring, and encouragement. This system helps students overcome academic challenges, build confidence, and grow into responsible individuals.

Internship Opportunities

With effect from the academic session 2023–24, as per National Education Policy 2020, Gauhati University has introduced a mandatory 4-credit Internship Course for undergraduate programmes. The Internship Programme is coordinated by the *Research and Development Cell (RDC)*, with its Coordinator serving as the Nodal Officer. Faculty members are actively involved as mentors and supervisors, providing continuous guidance, monitoring students' progress, and ensuring meaningful learning outcomes throughout the training period. Students are placed

in diverse organizations such as Krishi Vigyan Kendra, the Pollution Control Board, shopping malls, tea gardens, and private banks, thereby gaining valuable practical exposure and developing essential professional skills.



Career Counselling Cell

The Career Counselling Cell of PDUAM, Tulungia, established since the inception of the college, has been actively working to guide and empower students in making informed career choices. The Cell regularly organizes workshops, awareness programmes, and interactive sessions in collaboration with reputed institutions and organizations.

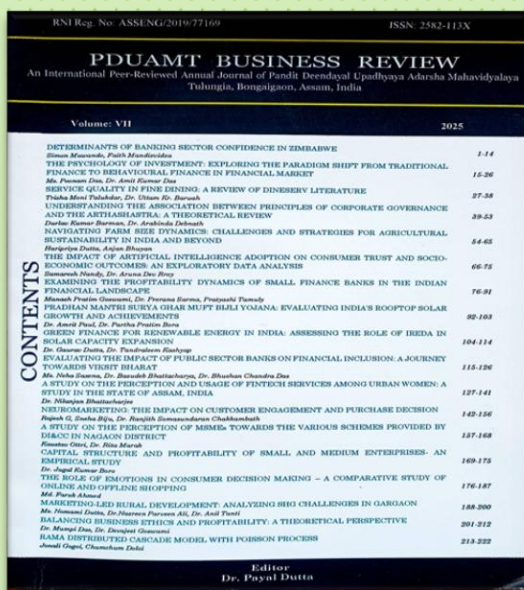

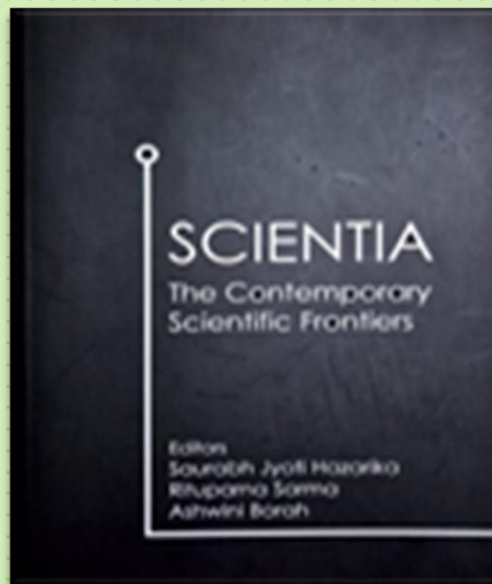
